

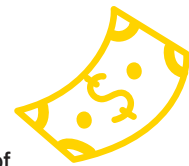
# What is money?

Oh no! All your money has fallen on the ground and is all mixed up! Can you draw a line to match up the piles of money that are worth the same amount?

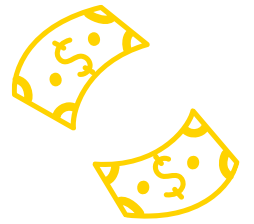
Handy hint: a couple of these money piles don't match up with any other groups, so instead of drawing a line can you write the total value next to the pile?
