All overseas transactions	Offshore Service Margins of 1.10% are charged on the converted New Zealand dollar amount of each cash transaction	Offshore Service Margins of 2.10% are charged on the converted New Zealand dollar amount of each transaction
The converted amount and the Offshore Service Margins will appear on your statement.		
You will be charged ASB FastCash card fees and margins if you select cheque or savings when using your ASB credit card overseas.

Important information about credit cards when you use them overseas

ASB Visa credit card

For overseas transactions	An Offshore Service Margin of 2.10% of the converted New Zealand dollar amount of the transaction will be charged to your card account.
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ASB Mastercard credit card

For overseas transactions not made at a Commonwealth Bank of Australia ATM	An Offshore Service Margin of 1.45% of the converted New Zealand dollar amount of the transaction will be charged to your card account. An additional Offshore Service Margin of 0.80% of the converted New Zealand dollar amount of the transaction will be charged where the transaction is made in a country other than New Zealand.
For overseas cash withdrawals made at a Commonwealth Bank of Australia ATM	An ASB Retail Exchange Margin of 0.70% of the converted New Zealand dollar amount of the transaction will be charged to your card account.
For purchases refunded back	The Offshore Service Margin of 1.45% is refunded back to your card account. The Offshore Service Margin of 0.80% is not refunded back to your card account. The margins that are refunded to your account by ASB may differ from the margins that were charged for the original transaction due to fluctuations in the conversion rate.

An overseas transaction is a transaction made in a currency other than New Zealand dollars. Overseas transactions will either first be converted into US dollars and then into New Zealand dollars or converted directly from the currency in which the overseas transaction was made into New Zealand dollars at an exchange rate selected by Visa, Mastercard or us (as the case may be) from available wholesale rates (or if applicable the Government mandated rate). In all cases the converted amount and the Offshore Service Margins or ASB Retail Exchange Margin will appear on your Card statement. You will be charged ASB FastCash card fees and margins if you select cheque or savings when using your ASB credit card overseas.
